- Controller's Office During Winter Break: The Controller's Office will be closed Dec. 25-26 and Jan. 1 for the holidays. From Dec. 23-Jan. 1, the Controller's Office will have limited staff and will not be doing a check run. Normal business hours will resume on Thursday, Jan. 2. The Travel and Accounts Payable (AP) offices will be working hard prior to Dec. 23 to get items complete. This will lead to tight deadlines the week of Dec. 16-20.
 - Travel All materials must be submitted and approved by Monday, Dec. 16, by 5 p.m.
 This will allow time to process prior to the check runs on Dec. 18 and 19. Travel will return to normal business hours on Thursday, Jan. 2.
 - Accounts Payable Check run deadline will be Tuesday, Dec. 17, by 5 p.m. This will give AP time to complete their process for the check run. If you will be out of the office, please plan accordingly and ensure timesheets are approved ahead of time. If you expect any delays, please notify Jane and/or Debie in payroll immediately.

As of Nov. 22, you no longer have access to your Idaho Optional Retirement Plan mutual fund account at Corebridge or TIAA. Your mutual fund balance transferred on Dec. 3, from Corebridge and on Dec. 4, from TIAA.
