1. Students complete all requirements for a TVCC AA degree.
2. TVCC students apply for admission to LCSC's Teacher Education Program during the first week of their final semester of their AA degree program. For admission requirements, please see: <https://www.lcsc.edu/education/program-application>
4. After earning the AA degree at TVCC, students complete requirements for the bachelor of science degree in elementary education with Idaho certification and the All Subjects K-8 endorsement at LCSC: 13 credits of coursework taken online, 12 semester credits of coursework in Summer I, 16 semester credits of course work in Summer II, and 16 semester credits of coursework in Internship II. If a second endorsement is desired/required the student will take an additional 12-13 semester credits of RE, SE, or MATH courses.
5. A minimum grade of C- is required for TVCC courses; a minimum GPA of 2.00 is required for the TVCC Associate's Degree. However, admission to LCSC's Teacher Education Program requires a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00 or higher.
