- This advising guide is based on completion of an Associate's degree (AA/AS) in Secondary Education at the College of Southern Idaho with additions made to meet lower division requirements.
- Students who transfer without being core complete may need to take additional LC State General Education core courses.
- 32 Residency (LC State) credits required for graduation/36 must be upper division.

A minimum grade of "C" or better and a minimum 3.0 GPA is required for all General Education courses. A minimum grade of "B-" or better is required in all Secondary Education Program courses. A minimum GPA of 3.0 must be maintained in the content area and in the cumulative overall grade point average.
