
Semesterly reminders:

- Canvas does not transfer grades to WarriorWeb; you must manually enter grades in WarriorWeb.
- Grades of Incomplete MUST be entered into WarriorWeb. Incomplete courses are processed in order of most recent expiration. Once the Registrar's office sends the list of Incomplete grades to our Canvas Admin, those courses will be re-opened for students receiving the incomplete and will remain open until the expiration date.

Canvas Update: New Quizzes Settings

Canvas has recently updated a setting feature within New Quizzes that will now allow faculty to preference how student recieve scores! Follow the directions below to activate these settings:

- 1. Within the 'Build' mode for a New Canvas Quiz, click on the 'Settings' tab located at the top.
- 2. In 'Settings,' scroll down to the bottom and toggle over the 'Hide results from students'.
- 3. From there, you want to have both 'Show questions' and 'Show student responses' toggled over.
- 4. There you will see in-depth setting preferences on when and how the student's scores are revealed.
