# Monday Message Feb. 10, 2025



Dear all,

The first weeks of the spring 2025 semester have flown by and we are holding strong. We are just three weeks away from our March 1 priority financial aid and scholarship deadline for the coming year. This date is important to both potential and current students.

While last year's FAFSA process was a bit kabobbled due to federal electronic submission and verification issues, the "normal" process maximizes potential student financial aid if they meet the March 1 deadline. When students complete FAFSAs, their information is reviewed to determine eligibility for Pell Grants and student loans. When they submit by the March 1 priority deadline, they are also evaluated for eligibility for college work-study and a federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (SEOG).

March 1 is also LC State's and the State Board of Education's scholarship deadline. By close of business on this date, LC State's scholarship portal will be closed and students who accessed the portal before or by March 1 will be considered for institutionally held scholarships. The State Board of Education lists March 1 as the deadline for students to apply for an Idaho Opportunity Scholarship (these scholarships are available for traditional students and adult learners who meet specific criteria). Students who currently have a State of Idaho Opportunity Scholarship must renew with the State Board by March 1. Students who currently have LAUNCH funding support, should have their scholarship automatically renewed as long as they continue to meet the maintenance criteria.

Please check out the short tutorial about the scholarship portal, and review information associated with the financial aid and scholarship processes. As you know, many LC State students are the first in their family to attend college and heavily dependent on financial aid to make it affordable. The more informed we all are, the better we can help and support our students, making pursuit of their education goals accessible and affordable!
