Syncing Microsoft Teams in Canvas

As LC State moved from a Google to Microsoft school, staff and faculty are now migrating from using Zoom of Microsoft Teams. Within Canvas, there is an integration for Microsoft Teams that can be found in the left-hand course menu bar in all your courses. If you do not see it in your course, go to 'Settings' within the course, click on the 'Navigation' tab, and enable the 'Microsoft Teams meetings' bar by clicking the three dots to enable or clicking and dragging the bar to the top list. Once active, you will need to sync your Microsoft Teams with Canvas to enable the 'Add entire class' button.

- 1. Go into the course you want to complete the syncing process with and click on the 'Settings' tab in the left-hand course menu bar.
- 2. Click on the 'Integrations' tab located at the top.
- 3. Within 'Integrations' tab, turn the toggle button for Microsoft Sync on to show green with a green checkmark.
- 4. Then click the drop-down menu for the Microsoft Sync heading and click the button 'Sync Now'. This will allow your Microsoft Teams Integration and Canvas to talk to each other.
- 5. Give that syncing a minute to process. Then you can go into you 'Microsoft Teams meetings' tab to create or adjust a meeting and that 'Add entire class' button should be purple and active for you to added everyone in the course to the meeting.

Due to recent updates, Canvas Discussion posts have gone through some minor changes that staff and faculty should be aware of. When you import content over from a previous course or build out new discussions, there is now a button that is sometimes enabled called 'Disallow threaded replies.' With this setting sometimes being checked, students will not be able to reply to their peers' discussion posts. If you notice your students are unable to interact with one another through discussion posts, go into the edit settings for the discussion post you would like to change, scroll down to the heading title 'Options,' check and see if the button titled 'Disallow threaded replies' is checked, if it is uncheck it, and then save the changes you've made to the discussion. Student will now have to ability to comment to one another's posts.

How to Panopto in Canvas

During the summer, eLearning Services was able to purchase new video recording and editing software that lives in Canvas as an integration. It is an amazing tool that makes capturing video, captioning, and embedding videos within a Canvas page easier for staff and faculty.
