- **Password Requirements:** New password requirements are being introduced for @lcsc.edu accounts. These changes are part of ongoing efforts to enhance security and protect institutional data. A long passphrase containing a string of words is stronger than a shorter, more complex password. The new requirement will take effect the next time you are required to change your password.
 - Minimum length: 14 characters
 - Password expiration: Every 12 months

The goal is to identify and inventory all paid software in use on campus to help identify blind spots for security purposes, and determine where LC State may be able to consolidate software purchases – thereby saving money and maximizing usage efficiencies.
