Dear all,

Our campus grounds are beginning to take shape – although waaaavvvv too many weeds persist and work will be ongoing over the next months and year. The SUB/CSL will be basically functional for the start of school – although still weeks away from the start-of-school WOW-factor we were hoping for. So far you will see the main floor has been restored from last winter's flood, walls have been refreshed, new lighting installed, and substantial changes in the appearance of the dining and food servery areas. New dining furniture, some finish work, and new flooring at the entrances are still pending. We ask that you be patient as delays have been largely beyond our control. Stay tuned for a true WOW-factor grand reopening event to be held in partnership with Sodexo, early- to mid-fall.

And finally, drumroll... the Living Learning Center (LLC) will be occupied by students this fall! We will house 15-20 students in the LCC, implementing a living-learning community/sleeping porch model. It has been a long process, and although I'm not exactly trumpeting that it's been worth the wait (the wait has been crazy-making!), I am delighted with the outcome and unique residential opportunity it will provide students.







A strength of our residence life programming is the range of options available. From traditional dorm rooms, to shared-space suites, main street lofts, residential houses, and now a true living-learning community, we have places and spaces to meet our students' housing needs.

For the third year in a row, we will begin the semester housing 44 students at the Hells Canyon Grand Hotel. As we have done before, we charge those students the same rate they would pay for on-campus housing, and we, LC State, cover the rest of the cost. We assign a Resident Assistant to the hotel and support student engagement targeted specifically to these students, in addition to ensuring that they are able to attend any and all campus events that may interest them. We do not want to turn anyone away from the pursuit of their education goals for the want of housing.

Currently, we have 419 bed spaces in our residence halls and 34 beds in our rental houses. With the 20 new residents in the LLC and the 44 students staying at the hotel, our residential population has increased by 14% since 2021!

This is further evidence that enrollment is stabilizing (even rebounding a bit), and can and will contribute to the vibrancy and energy of our campus community.
