- **Peer Mentor Applications:** The First Year Experience Program is currently seeking peer mentor recommendations for the fall 2025 semester. A peer mentor is a current student who has successfully completed at least one semester at LC and helps new freshmen build a foundation

for personal success at LC State. Peer mentors are friendly, reliable, and supportive and are able to demonstrate leadership qualities inside and outside the classroom. Mentors serve roughly 25 mentees 5-6 hours a week during orientation class, support programs (Orientation Day, Discovery Day, Homecoming, study nights, etc.), outreach and in-person meetings. • Performance Evaluations:

- **Forms** This year's Employee Performance Evaluation forms for Classified and Professional staff have been released and can be found on the <u>HR Website</u>.
- Job Description & Resume This year, an updated job description (using the updated job description template) is required to be sent with all evaluation forms for Classified and Professional staff. In alignment with best practices observed at colleges and universities across the country, LC State staff (CSO optional) are asked to submit an updated resume along with their performance evaluation so that we have the most current copy in the personnel files. All evaluations and job descriptions for Classified and Professional staff should be emailed to the HR office no later than Jan. 31. For questions email hr@lcsc.edu.
- CUPA Comparators A dashboard is available on the Intranet under Quick Links CUPA Comparators – for supervisors and employees to view their current CUPA comparators, as these are part of the job descriptions. Or, you may reach out to HRS directly if you would like to check the current comparator. CUPA comparators that are listed on the current job descriptions are specific to the time it was signed. These can change frequently with position updates, so it's important that the new comparators (if there are any changes) are entered on the updated job description. As job descriptions are received in HRS, the comparators will be reviewed and confirmed. If there are any changes, they will be updated, and a copy will be sent back to the supervisor and employee.
- Ratings This year, the "Exceeds" evaluation rating was updated on the evaluation forms to "Solid Sustained Performance" to align with the terminology used by the state (DHR and Luma). The definition used for "Exceeds" is the same definition used for "Solid Sustained Performance." Only the category name changed. This change can be found on the <u>Performance Management</u> website under the Performance Expectation Ratings section.
