- This advising guide is based on completion of an Associate's degree (AA/AS) in Elementary Education at the College of Southern Idaho with additions made to meet lower division requirements.
- Students who transfer without being core complete may need to take additional LC State General Education core courses.
- All Elementary Education Majors must pass the Praxis 5001 or 7811 series prior to internship I. Praxis exams required for endorsement area must be passed prior to internship II
- 32 Residency (LC State) credits required for graduation/36 must be upper division.

At CSI a minimum grade of "C-" is required for Gen Ed courses and a minimum 2.0 GPA is required to qualify for Associate's Degree.
