This course may also be taken online after admittance to the BSN, during a summer, before graduation.</i></p> <p>Students must have a minimum Sci/Stat GPA of 2.75 at the time of application; this includes the most recent attempt in Chem 102, Physiology, Anatomy, Microbiology and Statistics. No more than 2 of these courses may be in-progress at the time of application. All prerequisite courses must be passed with a grade of "C" or better. (Recommend cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better in these.)</p> <p>No TEAS required for LC State BSN. No references or healthcare volunteer/work experience required.
