No more than 2 of these courses may be in-progress at the time of application. All prerequisite courses must be passed with a grade of "C" or better. (Recommend cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better in these.)

No TEAS required for LC State BSN. No references or healthcare volunteer/work experience required. Applicants must have either a CNA or commit to completing an NA Skills Only course prior to the start of the BSN.
