- This advising guide is based on completion of an associates degree in Education at North Idaho College with additions made to meet lower division requirements.
- Students who transfer without an AA/AS may need to take additional LC State General Education core courses.
- 32 Residency (LC State) credits required for graduation.
- 36 credits must be upper division.
- All 300/400 level ED/RE/SE courses require a grade of "B-" or better. A 3.0 GPA is required for admission to LC State's Teacher Education Program and to qualify for graduation.
- Students are advised to complete an Associates Degree (AA/AS) prior to attending LC State.

A minimum grade of "C-" or better is required for all Gen Ed courses and a minimum 2.0 GPA is required to qualify for Associate's degree.
