- Course Evaluation Dashboard Update: LC State has upgraded to a streamlined course
  evaluation platform. Deans, chairs, and faculty have been provided with login credentials for
  Qualtrics, where they can access the new Course Evaluation Dashboard. This platform
  incorporates the updated evaluation questions designed by the Faculty Senate, with input from
  the Faculty Association, and approved by the Provost. This new system aims to enhance usability
  and ensure timely access to course evaluation data. Once logged in, users can navigate the
  dashboard, which features three pages:
  - 1. **Response Rate Page:** Displays real-time response rates for courses.
  - 2. Course Feedback Page: Provides feedback data related to courses.
    - Initially, this page will display data only for Session A courses. Data for 16-week and Session B courses will be available after final grades are submitted.
  - 3. Instructor Feedback Page: Displays feedback data specific to instructors.
    - Like the Course Feedback Page, this page will initially show only Session A data.
       Data for 16-week and Session B courses will be added once grades are finalized.
- **Fidelity:** Just a friendly reminder that your Idaho Optional Retirement Plan is moving to Fidelity. As of Nov. 22, you no longer have access to your Idaho Optional Retirement Plan mutual fund account at Corebridge or TIAA. Your mutual fund balance will transfer on Dec. 3, from Corebridge and on Dec. 4, from TIAA.
