This agreement provides for escrow credits, which are a means for nurses to be granted academic credits for previous nursing knowledge. There is a fee of \$20.00 per escrow credit to have these credits appear on the student's transcript. <b>CWI students taking only the minimum credits required for their ASN may need up to 28 escrow credits.</b>
